

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU COME TO THE CLINIC

Before you come:

The referrals team will ask you simple questions to enable registration with the clinic and to provide some background for the consultant.

You will be able to choose when you come in and who you wish to see. The referrals team will guide you through the options.

The booking will be passed on to the consultant who may ask you to come to the hospital in advance of the consultation for some tests. The referrals team will organise and schedule this with you.

You will be asked to provide information in relation to funding of your treatment, whether through insurance authorisation details or request for payment before any tests are carried out. The referrals team will be able to provide a rough estimate of the costs before you commit.

On arrival:

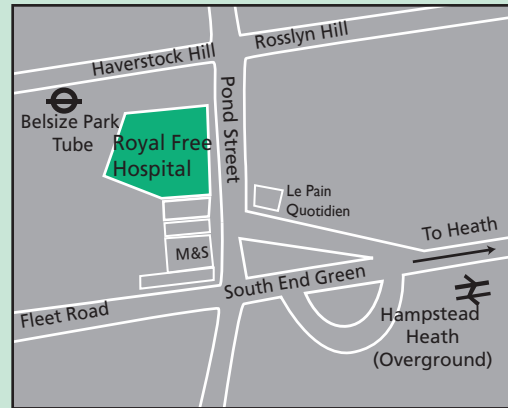

On completion of the appointment:

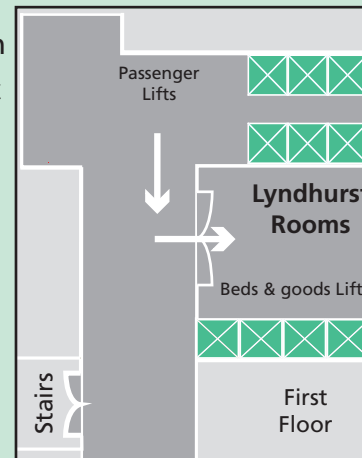
